CONGRATULATIONS TO FIRST YEAR PLAYER JOSHUA HENDERSON IN HE'S FIRST YEAR OF BASEBALL. WHILST NOT HAVING A GREAT DEAL OF SUCCESS, THE SEASON WAS NONETHELESS MOST ENJOYABLE WITH ALL TEAM MEMBERS GETTING ON VERY WELL TOGETHER, WHICH MADE FOR AN OVERALL FRIENDLY AND SOCIABLE SEASON.

UNFORTUNATELY, THE TEAM MAINLY COMPRISING PLAYERS OF 5TH AND 6TH GRADE STANDARD AND WITH FIVE NEW PLAYERS TO THE GAME, FOR REASONS OF LOGISTICS AND CONVENIENCE, WERE ENTERED INTO A VERY STRONG 4TH GRADE COMPETITION. THIS GRADE PROVED TO BE WAY ABOVE OUR LEVEL OF EXPERTISE AND EXPERIENCE.

ONLY ONE PLAYER, PETER BERGQVIST, PLAYED IN ALL GAMES. OUR MAIN PITCHER AND BEST BATTER, KYLE DUNCAN, CEASED PLAYING WITH THREE ROUNDS REMAINING OWING TO HIS ACCEPTANCE INTO THE AIR FORCE. JASON BARTLETT FORTUNATELY WAS A LATE STARTER SIGNING ON FROM SATURDAY, 14/7/2018. WE UNFORTUNATELY LOST THE SERVICES OF DYLAN BARTLETT WITH THREE ROUNDS TO GO DUE TO HIS PROMOTION TO 3RD GRADE. BRAD MCDONNELL, ONE OF OUR BETTER ALL-ROUND PLAYERS, WAS ONLY ABLE TO PLAY IN EIGHT OF OUR GAMES OWING TO WORK COMMITMENTS.

THE TEAM WON (2) FROM THE (16) GAMES PLAYED FINISHING 7TH FROM THE FOLLOWING (7) TEAMS THAT COMPETED IN THE 4TH GRADE COMPETITION.

MAITLAND, BELMONT SEAGULLS, PHOENIX CHARLESTOWN, TORONTO, UNIVERSITY, WHITE SOX, BOOMERANGS.

4TH GRADE REPORT

FOUR OF OUR GAMES WERE LOST BY THE MARGIN OF ONLY 1, 4, 1 AND 3 RUNS. HOWEVER, WE EXPERIENCED FIVE CRUSHING DEFEATS COMPRISING 20/1, 19/1, 25/0, 24/0 AND 25/1. THERE WERE THREE BYES DURING THE COURSE OF THE SEASON. WE SCORED (82) RUNS IN TOTAL, BUT HAD (238) SCORED AGAINST US. WE HAD A TOTAL (84) HITS FOR, BUT HAD (197) HITS AGAINST US.

SHOWING SOME SIGNS OF IMPROVEMENT AS THE SEASON PROCEEDED WE BECAME MORE COMPETITIVE ONCE WE CUT DOWN ON THE NUMBER OF ERRORS WHICH WERE A FEATURE OF THE MAJORITY OF OUR GAMES. BASE RUNNING, LEADS WHEN ON BASE AND CONCENTRATION ALL NEED TO IMPROVE OVERALL IF SUCCESS IS TO BE ACHIEVED BY OUR PLAYERS IN FUTURE SEASONS.

KYLE DUNCAN WAS OUR STAND OUT BATTER WITH A (.546) BATTING AVERAGE WHILST BRAD MCDONNELL (.350), GAVIN RANKIN (.333), JUSTIN STEADMAN (.333) AND BODIE SMITH (.310) ALL ACHIEVED REASONABLE BATTING AVERAGES. JAMES WITHER, WITH ONLY (19) PLATE APPEARANCES, MANAGED A (.500) BATTING AVERAGE.

PITCHING DUTIES WERE CARRIED OUT PRIMARILY BY KYLE DUNCAN, JUSTIN STEADMAN AND TYLER ALLEN WHILST DEAN GALLUCCI, DYLAN BARTLETT, GAVIN RANKIN, JAMES WITHER, JORI ATKINSON, JASON BARTLETT AND JOHN MOSSOP WERE ALL ALSO CALLED UPON TO HELP OUT. OUR PITCHERS WERE QUITE OFTEN LET DOWN BY ERRORS AND A LACK OF CONCENTRATION AND AWARENESS IN THE FIELD. A LENIENT (63) ERRORS WERE RECORDED ACROSS THE SEASON.

WE USED FOUR CATCHERS DURING THE SEASON INCLUDING TYLER ALLAN, JASON BARTLETT, BRAD MCDONNELL AND DYLAN BARTLETT.
